## AI Art in Reality - From Virtual to Real

We are hosting a rare AI art exhibition where visitors can experience the wonder of AI-generated art as tangible, framed pieces, transcending the limitations of online viewing on platforms like Instagram.

The venue is located just a 2-3 minute walk from the Mauritshuis Museum, home to masterpieces such as Vermeer's "Girl with a Pearl Earring" and "View of Delft," and Rembrandt's "The Anatomy Lesson of Dr. Nicolaes Tulp." In the historic city of The Hague, renowned for its collection of masterpieces, we present an exhibition showcasing the works of cutting-edge AI artists.

This option allows you to sell your artwork as A6 postcards at the venue. For an additional fee of €25, we will print 10 cards to be sold for €8 each. Please check the postcard sales option box on the application form if interested.

#### Deadlines & Process

- Application Deadline: Sunday, November 16, 2025
- Artwork Data Submission Deadline: Sunday, November 23, 2025 (must be received) (Please submit your work in JPG, PNG, or PDF format with a resolution of 300dpi or higher.)

## Regarding Artwork Sales

 All exhibited works will be available for sale. Please indicate the selling price of your work on the application form(Euro).

 Communications Factory Europe will mediate sales, handle payment processing, and ship artwork to buyers. A 30% commission will be deducted from the selling price to cover these services, with the remaining amount deposited into the artist's designated account.

 Purchased artwork will not be taken home immediately. A "Sold" notice will be displayed, and the artwork will remain on display for the duration of the exhibition. It will be shipped to the buyer approximately 7 days after the exhibition ends.  Artwork Data Submission Deadline: 7th, July 2025 (Please submit data with Aspect Retio of your selected size a resolution of 300dpi or higher in JPG, PNG, or PDF format)

 Artwork Data Submission Deadline for Plexiglas, Canvas Print and Aluminium

Print: 7th July 2025.

### Additional Benefits

- Artist Showcase: Each artist will be featured in a printed booklet distributed at the exhibition, including a profile, selected another artworks, and a QR code linking to their Instagram or other social media.
- Online Sales: Artwork will be available for online sale on the gallery's website for up to 6 months after the exhibition. If sold online, a 30% commission will be deducted, and the remaining amount will be deposited into the artist's account, similar to physical sales at the exhibition.
